Sub: Servicing of Cape size/ Baby cape size vessels at Paradip Port

In continuation to the Trade Circular No.TD/TM/GEN-201/1829 dated 07.07.2020, the competent authority has been pleased to approve the following:

- i) Cape size vessels and Baby cape size vessels of more than 13 Mtrs draft will not be accepted for handling in the GCBs after 31.08.2020.
- ii) Acceptance of Baby Cape vessels upto 260 Mtrs LOA, 45 Mtrs beam and 13.00 Mtrs draft for berthing at EQ3 berth, duly following the extant Berthing Policy, subject to availability of berth.
- iii) Acceptance of Baby Cape vessels upto 260 Mtrs LOA, 45 Mtrs beam and 12.50 Mtrs draft for berthing at SQ / EQ 3 berths, duly following the extant Berthing Policy, subject to availability of berth.

The above proposals will be implemented w.e.f. 01.09.2020 till further review.

However, MV JUBILANT DEVOTION having LOA 245 Mtrs, Beam 43.53 Mtrs and Draft 14.50 Mtrs, which has arrived PPT anchorage on 27.08.2020, will be accepted for berthing at CQ1 berth, duly following the extant Berthing Policy, which is as per Trade Circular No.TD/TM/GEN-201/1829 dated 07.07.2020.

PPT, accordingly, requests the trade fraternity and the service providers to take advantage of the above facility by nominating Baby cape size vessels for handling in the Port.
