Trade Notice: Gangway and Pilot Ladder Safety Instructions for Vessels Calling at JSW Jaigad Port

## For Attention of Vessel Masters and Crew Calling JSW Jaigad Port

To prevent hazardous situations while accessing a vessel by gangway or by the pilot ladder for embarking or disembarking at sea or berth, safety precautions must be taken by vessel crew while rigging gangways or pilot ladders to prevent injuries to ship crew, port personnel, and port pilots. In view of this, all Masters and crew are advised to comply with the following:

Providing safe access to a ship is an integral part of ensuring safe working practices and maintaining a secure environment on board, as required by SOLAS Chapter V, Regulation 23, and MSC.1/Circ.1331 – Guidelines for the construction, installation, maintenance, and inspection/survey of means of embarkation and disembarkation – which provides specific guidance for accommodation ladders and gangways under SOLAS Regulation II-1/3-9 as amended.

Accordingly, the following safety precautions are the minimum requirements for all vessels calling at JSW Jaigad Port:

- The Vessel Master must ensure the safe rigging of the Pilot Ladder as per SOLAS Ch-V, Reg. 23 and IMO A.1045 (27) and inform Port Control regarding safe access for pilot boarding and disembarking.
- The gangway must always be manned by vessel crew with a handheld walkie-talkie or other suitable means of communication.
- The Master and crew are responsible for providing a safe means of access for embarking or disembarking.
- The Master must ensure a safe means of access, even if the gangway is provided from the shore-side.
- The gangway must be promptly placed in position after securing the vessel and remain in place as long as the vessel is alongside.
- The gangway should be properly rigged, secured, deployed, and safe to use.
- 7. The gangway and immediate approaches must be adequately illuminated.
- Main engines must not be tried out when the shore gangway is placed, without prior intimation to JSW Jaigad Port Control on VHF Ch-11.
- The maximum SWL of the gangway must not be exceeded, and a maximum of persons as per marked should be allowed on the gangway at any given time.
- 10. The gangway must be adjusted periodically to maintain safe access.







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11. A lifebuoy with a self-activating light and a safety line attached to a quoit or similar device should be readily available near the gangway.

During rigging, seafarers must be mindful of their safety and follow height safety guidelines, including using fall prevention devices and lifejackets. Any non-compliance with these safety measures will be treated as a serious safety violation and immediately reported to relevant agencies for inspection.
