Sub: Handling of Calcite Chips at Mumbai Port Request for storage facilities.

Vide Circular dated 31.07.2021, trade was informed about the extension of facility of storage of import agricultural products upto 180 days in Outlying Areas and 60 days inside Docks, for a period of one year upto 31.07.2022.

- As per demand from the trade, the Board of Mumbai Port Authority has 2. approved to Nominate/Notify open area either near Brown Gate or in C Section for storage of Import Calcite Chips under provisions of Section 3.3 (A) (II) of Chapter III of Scale of Rates (SOR).
- Accordingly, an open area admeasuring approx.1800 sq.mtrs. near Brown Gate is nominated for storage of Import Calcite Chips under provisions of Section 3.3 (A) (II) of Chapter III of Scale of Rates (SOR).
- It may also be noted that the abovesaid Section 3.3(A)(II) of SOR prescribes charges upto a maximum period of 60 days only. The cargo lying beyond 60 days shall be subjected to demurrage from 61st day onwards under provision of Section 3.1(B) of SOR. For the purpose of levy of demurrage, the 61st day of storage of cargo will be treated as day number one.
- It is requested to give wide publicity amongst your members to above, so as to avail the facility and bring in more Calcite Chips Cargo.
